Pour on the pure joy of chocolate

Houston native Lynn Lasher "traded her power suit for an apron" in 2005 and brought to market a new chocolate sauce from a family recipe (so goes the press release).

Somebody's Mother's Chocolate Sauce is more solid than most, with a slightly grainy texture reminiscent of fudge.

Our tasters found it satisfyingly rich and sweet - ingredients are heavy cream, sugar, butter and unsweetened chocolate - though one thought it could be more chocolaty.
