This new dessert topping is darker than milk chocolate but mellower than dark chocolate. **Somebody's Mother's Chocolate Sauce** is made for spooning over fruit or ice cream, but we happen to know it tastes swell straight from the jar. Fiftysomething mom and businesswoman Lynne Lasher of Houston created the product and launched it last fall.

The mom theme extends to the "lid lit" atop each jar. One of seven quotes is printed (including: "If you bungle raising your children, nothing else much matters in life" — Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis).
